

Acrylic/Metal Print Hanging Instructions Using Aluminum Standoffs

(Standoffs, Screw(s) and Anchor(s) included):

Materials / Tools Needed:



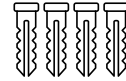
Acrylic / Metal Print



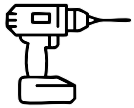
Aluminum Standoffs
(ensure you have the
right size for your print)



Screws
(right size to
secure standoffs)



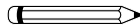
Wall Anchors
(if needed for mounting
in drywall)



Drill
(with a drill bit matching
the standoff screws)



Tape Measure



Pencil



Screwdriver



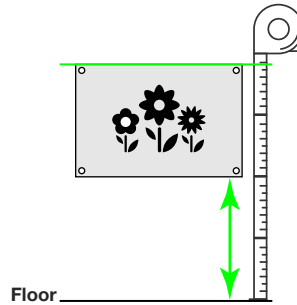
Level

STEP 1: CHOOSE THE LOCATION

- Decide where you want to hang your print. Consider the lighting and surrounding decor.

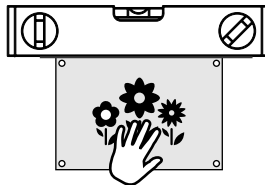
STEP 2: MEASURE AND MARK

- Use the measuring tape to determine the height at which you want to hang the print.

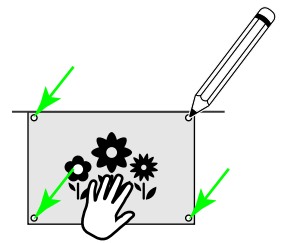


STEP 3: MARK STANDOFF POSITIONS

- Hold the print in position and check it with the level. Adjust if necessary.

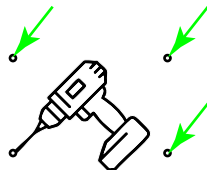


- Hold the print in position and use a pencil to mark the center of the holes.

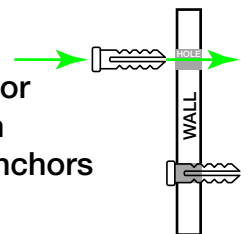


STEP 4: DRILL PILOT HOLES / INSTALL ANCHORS

- Use the drill to make pilot holes at the center of the marked locations.



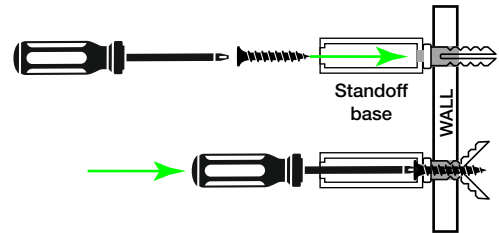
- If your print is heavy, or you're mounting it on drywall, insert wall anchors into the drilled holes.



STEP 5: INSTALL STANDOFFS

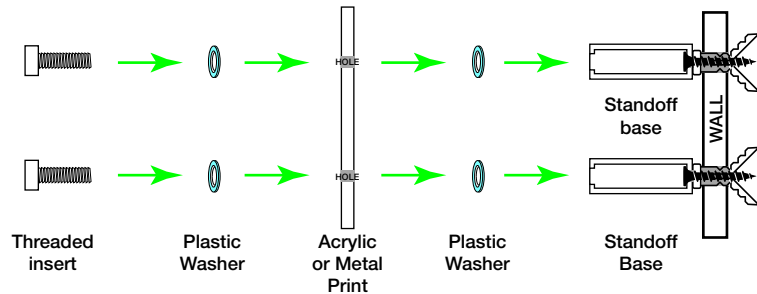
- Use your screwdriver to install the base of the standoffs into the holes or wall anchors

Standoff threaded insert and plastic washers (remove for this step)

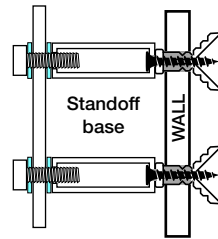


STEP 6: HANG THE PRINT

- Position a plastic washer behind and in front of each hole in the print.



- Put the threaded inserts through the holes and plastic washers and screw them into the bases loosely until all the inserts are in.



- Tighten the inserts.

FINAL TIPS:

- **SAFETY FIRST -**
If your print is large or heavy, consider having someone assist you.
- **DOUBLE CHECK MEASUREMENTS -**
Take your time measuring to ensure the standoffs are evenly spaced and level.
- **CLEANING -**
Clean the print with a soft microfiber cloth before and after hanging to ensure it looks its best.

Now you're ready to display your beautiful print.
